- Develops well-rounded life-long learners who are adaptable and ready to engage with complex global challenges



The DP (ages 16-19) offers a rigorous academic curriculum that prepares students for success in higher education and beyond. It emphasises depth of knowledge across six subject groups, critical thinking through the Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course, research skills in the Extended Essay (EE), and a dedication to creativity,

activity, and service (CAS). The DP develops not only academic competence but also resilience and a mindset of lifelong learning.

Our highly-qualified staff delivers the IB Diploma is the gold standard of international education and recognised as such by colleges and universities around the world. Our students take multiple languages, have multiple options for Individuals and Societies, and Sciences. They also take mathematics and have the option of Visual Arts, while completing required TOK, EE, and CAS work.
